

Project Completion Notification

BYWAY 93 BRAINTREE & BOCKING SURFACE IMPROVEMENT

SCHEME OBJECTIVE: The existing route with its status as Byway provides an off-road walking, cycling and horse riding, carriage driving and motorised vehicular opportunity for the local community.

The route had become highly waterlogged and rutted, with collapsed ditches making it very difficult to negotiate and preventing some from using it. Therefore, the purpose of the scheme was to undertake substantial improvement works (drainage and surfacing) to improve accessibility for all users.

SCHEME SUMMARY & OUTCOME: Infilling of ruts with suitable graded material and overlaying with road planings. Reinstating collapsed ditches and replacing pipework running under the byway and connecting parallel ditches. Clearance of vegetation to the sides and clearance of ditches where necessary in order to remove encroachments and make the route easier for all users. The outcome of the works is a much improved surface of this byway that has both a rural look and feel about it which allows the a much safer passage of users along it.

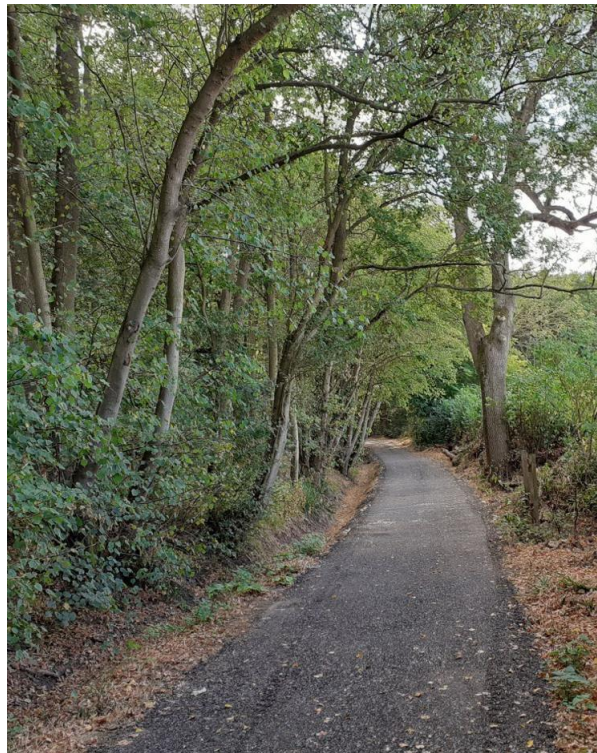
