**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023  
BRIDLEWAY 14 WIDDINGTON**

On 6 November 2023 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the order as confirmed as shown on the order map is divert part lengths of Bridleway 14 Widdington of unknown width shown by bold continuous lines on the order map commencing from a point north of a paddock area running in a southerly direction through the paddock area for a total distance of 107 metres to the point where it connects to Hollow Road, to an alternative route 3 meters in width commencing at the aforementioned start point running in first an easterly then southerly direction around the outside of the paddock area for a total distance of 137 metres to a point where it meets Hollow Road 28 metres east of the connection.

A further section of Bridleway 14 Widdington commencing from a point on the southern side of Hollow Road running in a generally southerly direction across a grass area for a total distance of 8 metres to the point where it continues unaffected, to an alternative route 3 meters in width commencing at a point 33 metres east of the current connection running in a south westerly direction across a grass area for a total distance of approximately 37 metres to the aforementioned end point where it continues unaffected.

# Public notice

The alternative route will come into force on 4 December 2023 and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 11 December 2023, but if a person aggrieved by the orders wants to question their validity, or that of any provision contained in them, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 16 November 2023 make an application to the High Court.
