

The Essex County Council (Robinson Close, Great Bromley) (20MPH Zone) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 (1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on hour on the said lengths of road, in Great Bromley, in the District of Tendring, as specified in the schedule to this order.
2. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order shall come into operation on ** *** 202* and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Robinson Close, Great Bromley, District of Tendring) (20MPH Zone) Order 202*

Robinson Close	From a point approximately 7 metres south of its junction with Mary Lane North, south and east for the rest of its remaining length approximately 124 metres.
