Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 84(1) (a) and (2) and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The Effect of the Order: To introduce a 20mph zone in Great Bromley in the District of Tendring.

To Implement a 20mph Zone in Great Bromley in the District of Tendring.

Road	Description
Robinson Close	From a point approximately 7 metres south of its junction with Mary Lane North, south and east for the rest of its remaining length approximately 124 metres.
