he Essex County Council (Former A120 (B1256) various Parishes, Uttlesford) (Various Speed Limits) (Part 1) Order 2006

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2), 82 (2), 83(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- The lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- The roads and lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this Order shall cease to be restricted roads for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act.
- 4. The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Restricted Road) Order 2006; The Essex County Council (Uttlesford) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2006; The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Stansted Mountfitchet, Little Dunmow and Great Dunmow) (De-Restriction) Order 2002 and The Essex County Council (A120 Buildings Farm Roundabout Victoria Roundabout, Great Dunmow) (De-Restriction of affected roads) Order 2004 are hereby revoked in so far as they relate to those roads specified in Schedule 1, 2 and 3 to this Order only.
- This Order may be cited as The Essex County Council (Former A120 (B1256) various Parishes, Uttlesford) (Various Speed Limits) (Part 1) Order 2006 and shall come into operation on 14 July 2006.

SCHEDULE 1

Restricted Roads

Lengths of road formerly known as the A120 in the Parishes of Takeley and Little Canfield:

B1256 Dunmow Road

From a point approximately 184 metres east of the junction with the B183 Station Road and Parsonage Road, eastwards to a point approximately 50 metres east of Thornton Road, a total distance of approximately 1454 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

40mph Speed Limit

Lengths of road formerly known as the A120 and adjacent Roads in the Parishes of Great Hallingbury, Takeley, Little Canfield and Great Dunmow:

B1256 Dunmow/Stortford Road

From a point 370 metres east of its junction with Bury Lodge Lane eastwards to a point 508 metres west of its junction with the B183 Takeley to Harlow Road.

B1256 Start Hill/Dunmow Road

From a point approximately 130 metres west of Bedlar's Green Road eastwards to a point approximately 15 metres east of its junction with Stansted Distribution Centre, a total distance of 710 metres.

B1256 Dunmow Road

From a point approximately 508 metres west of the junction with the B183 Station Road and Parsonage Road, westwards to a point approximately 132 metres east of its junction with Forest Road, a total distance of approximately 693 metres.

B1256 Dunmow Road (Stortford Road)

From a point approximately 50 metres east of the junction with Thornton Road, eastwards to a point approximately 175 metres west of the junction with High Cross Lane West, a total distance of 1309 metres.

B1256 Stortford Road

From a point approximately 60 metres west of Woodside Way roundabout eastwards to a point 40 metres south-east of Victoria roundabout, a total distance of approximately 680 metres.

(B184 Stortford Road)

From its junction with Victoria roundabout northeastwards for a total distance of approximately 20 metres

(Woodside Way)

From its junction with Woodside Way roundabout northwards for a distance of approximately 30 metres.
