## The Essex County Council (A104 Epping New Road, Buckhurst Hill) (Restricted Road) Order 2008

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 (2); 83 (2); 84(1) and (2); and Part IV to Schedule 9 to the Act, of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III to Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. The lengths of road in the Parish of Buckhurst Hill, in the District of Epping Forest, as specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act.
- 2. This Order may be cited as The Essex County Council (A104 Epping New Road, Buckhurst Hill) (Restricted Road) Order 2008 and shall become operational on 23 March 2008.
- 3. This Order revokes Trunk Roads (40 M.P.H. Speed Limit) (No. 23) Order 1969, insofar as it relates to the County of Essex only.
