- 1. The lengths of road in Great Dunmow, in the District of Uttlesford specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Restricted Road) Order 2006 is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to Great Dunmow only.
- This Order may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Dunmow) (Restricted Roads) Order 2010 and shall come into operation on 8 March 2010.

Lengths of road in Great Dunmow in the District of Uttlesford

B184 Ongar Road From a point approximately 32 metres east of the driveway entrance to the property called 'Oaklands', southwest, for a distance of approximately 110 metres. From its junction with B1057 Church Street and The Beaumont Hill Causeway, northwest, , to a point approximately 40 metres north of the access road to the Helena Romanes School, a distance of approximately 439 metres. Braintree Road From a point approximately 120 metres southwest of its junction with St. Edmunds Lane, east, to its junction with the access road to Ford Farm, a distance of approximately 295 metres. Stortford Road From its junction with B184 High Street, west, for a distance of approximately 696 metres. The Causeway From its junction with B1057 Church Street and Beaumont Hill, south, for a distance of approximately 302 metres. B184 The (Chelmsford Road, High Street, Market Place, North Street Dunmow/Stump and The Causeway). Cross Road From a point approximately 62 metres south of its junction with Station Road, north, to a point approximately 46 metres north of its junction with Rosemary Lane, a distance of approximately 853 metres. B1057 The Great (Church Street and Church End). Dunmow/Haverhill From its junction with The Causeway and Beaumont Hill, Road northeast, to a point approximately 121 metres northeast of its junction with St. Edmunds Lane, a distance of approximately 616 metres.
