<p>6.</p>	<p><b>Finance Update:</b></p> <p>It was reported that financial information relating to Braintree Local Highways Panel would be discussed at a meeting of County-wide Local Highways Panel representatives which would be held at Country Hall, Chelmsford on 3rd April 2018. In the circumstances, it was agreed that the consideration of this Item should be deferred to the next meeting of the Panel.</p> <p><b>Action By: Sonia Church, Essex Highways. <p>7.</p>	<p><b>Approved Works Programme:</b></p> <p>Consideration was given to a report setting out a programme of schemes which the Panel had recommended for approval. The report provided an update on the current position of all schemes which had been recommended for inclusion in the 2017/18 programme of work. The schemes denoted in 'green' had been completed; those denoted in 'grey' had been cancelled and could be removed from the schedule; and those denoted in 'yellow' were to provide an update to the Local Highways Panel.</p> <p>The report also included schemes which had been prioritised at the Panel's meeting in January 2018 for implementation in 2018/19. These schemes were subject to formal approval by Essex County Council's Cabinet Member for Highways.</p> <p>It was reported that the capital budget for Braintree Local Highways Panel for 2018/19 would be £407,789. It was proposed that £288,500 of this sum should be allocated to schemes which had been prioritised for implementation in 2018/19; £8,500 to schemes re-profiled from 2017/18 to 2018/19; and £126,500 to safer roads schemes. In total this amounted to an overspend of £15,711. However, Members of the Panel were advised that final scheme costs could change. Members of the Panel were also advised that Essex Highways had assigned a 'Direct Delivery Team' for all 12 Local Highways Panels. The Team would comprise three members of staff who would carry out small scale schemes such as signing; lining; and kerbing specifically for the Panels. It was anticipated that this new service would improve effectiveness and efficiency and reduce costs. It was suggested that the role of the Direct Delivery Team should be discussed at the next meeting for the Panel.</p> <p>Reference was made to the significant proportion of the Panel's budget (£126,500), which had been earmarked by Essex County Council's Cabinet Member for Highways for safer roads schemes. However, it was reported that a decision had not yet been made as to exactly how these schemes should be funded. It was suggested</p>	

	<p>that this matter should be raised at the meeting of County-wide Local Highways Panel representatives which would be held at Country Hall, Chelmsford on 3rd April 2018.</p> <p>Members of the Panel drew attention to a flooding issue at Mill Lane/Guithavon Valley, Witham, which was causing problems in a well-used area serving a care home, schools and commuters. The relevant Authorities were aware of the problem, which related to the inadequacy of existing drains and blocking by leaves, and insufficient drainage. It was mentioned that a feasibility study had been carried out, but potential funding had had to be allocated to other schemes. It was hoped that the work could be funded from other sources.</p> <p>Councillor D Smith stated that there was a discrepancy between the version of the Approved Works Programme included within the Panel's Agenda and the Programme which was available to view on Braintree District Council's website. 2018/19 Approved Works Programme Budget Summary**

The following report provides an update on the current position of all of the schemes which the Braintree District Local Highway Panel (LHP) had recommended for inclusion in the 2018/19 Works Programme.

The Approved Works Programme is shown in two parts, firstly those schemes for delivery within the 2018/19 financial year and secondly those schemes which are within the rolling programme for future delivery.

The scheme finish dates have been allocated financial year quarters until such a time that we have an accurate month for delivery and the road space has been booked, whereupon the month can be shown.

For the information of the Panel our Safer Roads team have identified 7 Safer Roads schemes within the Braintree District which need to be delivered in 2018/19.

Members are also reminded that the costs supplied are estimates only and there is the possibility that a final scheme cost could change significantly dependant on issues which may arise especially during detailed design and construction. The estimated scheme costs on the Rolling Programme/Potential Scheme List have been reviewed and adjusted as necessary to reflect this.
