CASTLE POINT BOROUGH COUNCIL WITH ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL – 17TH JANUARY 2019 REPORT 2 – POTENTIAL CAPITAL SCHEMES

It is envisaged that the 2019/20 Capital budget for the Castle Point LHP will be the same as that in 2018/19 (£228,675), though this will be finalised by ECC at their full Council meeting in February 2019.

There are four Casualty Reduction schemes in Castle point which will need to be funded from the Capital budget so this figure is subject to change once the costs have been confirmed. It will also be necessary to give consideration to funding any projects which have not been completed in 2018-19.
