4. Matters Arising from the Minutes of 4th July:

The Highways Liaison Officer said she had followed up the enquiry regarding the development of a pedestrian safe zone on a bridge in Stebbing. The Structure team at Essex Highways were determining if the safe zone was viable and the conclusion would be reported back to this panel.

5. Public Question Time

Tom White and Bob Ottaway attended the meeting on behalf of Audley End Miniature Railway, seeking guidance on reducing the speed limit from 60mph to 30mph on Audley End Road.

Members were informed that footfall had increased by 25% in the past three years at the Miniature Railway, with 40% of visitors travelling from over 45 minutes away. This had led to an over reliance on the use of the over-spill car park, located a few minutes' walk from the attraction.

The walk to and from the over-spill car park was hazardous, particularly when the majority of visitors to the Railway were families with young children. Mr White said access to the site would be improved if the speed limit was reduced to 30mph and asked for guidance from the Panel on how to achieve this.

The Highway Liaison Officer said a set of criteria would need to be met if a reduction of the speed limit was to be achieved. As such a request had failed previously, this could prove problematic. However, as there had been an increase in visitor numbers to the attraction, there could be grounds for looking at this again. Councillor Asker said the one-way system implemented on Wenden Road had also exacerbated the situation and was further grounds for reviewing the situation. Councillor Freeman agreed and said support should be given to the Miniature Railway as it was a valued local employer and tourist attraction.

The Highway Liaison Manager said speed and volume surveys could be carried out on both Audley End Road and Wenden Road to quantify the changes that had taken place. Such evidence would be required if a reduction in speed limit was to be attained.

Members agreed to conduct speed surveys on the aforementioned roads.

The Highways Officer said the allocation process would begin again in January and confirmation on what could be done would be available then.

The Chairman thanked Mr White and Mr Ottaway for attending and said the Panel would do what they could to help them.

6. Approved Works Programme

The Highways Liaison Officer updated members on the approved Works Programme and highlighted the following schemes:

5. Duck Street, Little Easton – speed limit request



Councillor Freeman asked why the implementation of this speed limit request had cost £7,000. The Highway Liaison Officer said legal, advertising and traffic management costs were significant outlays and had contributed to the total spend.

8. Sampford Road, Thaxted - new footway design

The design for the new footway along the Sampford Road between Bellrope Meadow and the new Knights' development had been completed. Members were asked if they wanted to go ahead with the footway and to allocate £12,000 to begin development in April 2018.

Members agreed to allocate funding for the footway.

12. Manuden Road / The Street, Manuden – kerbing and drainage design

Members were told that the design had been changed due to the successful work carried out on the drainage system in the area. This had led to savings to the scheme.

15. The Endway, Great Easton – Installation of new footway

The design for the footway would be completed before April 2018 and this would provide a more accurate estimated cost. Initially, the estimated cost of the installation was £130,000 but if this was exceeded Members would be asked to reaffirm their commitment to proceed.

18. Castle Street j/w Museum Street, Saffron Walden – feasibility for junction realignment

Councillor Asker asked if the scheme had already been completed as she had seen work being carried out on the junction and the road markings were much clearer. The Highway Liaison Officer said re-surfacing had been completed by the maintenance team but this was unrelated to the junction realignment scheme. The Chairman said it would be a good idea to monitor the situation to see if the resurface work and new markings deterred the public from incorrectly using the one-way system to gain access to the Doctor's Surgery.

31. Bridleway 36 Clavering – further surface improvements following on from works undertaken in 2014

The Highway Liaison Officer asked Members to prioritise the Approved Schemes for delivery in 2018/19. The Highway team recommended 'Bridleway 36 Clavering' as a priority.

Members agreed to include this scheme for delivery in 2018/19.

7 Potential Schemes List

The Highways Liaison Officer presented her report on Potential Schemes



	2018/19. She told Members to submit scheme requests for 2018/19 before the end of October to ensure the necessary assessments could take place. 27. North Hall Bridge, Quendon – advanced height restriction signage In response to a question from Councillor Gooding, the Highways Liaison Officer said she would need the original document to hand to clarify the exact location of the bridge. She would report back her findings at the next meeting. The report was noted.	
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8.	Highway Rangers	
	The Highways Liaison Officer presented her report on the Rangers work for the months of April through to July. Much work had been completed, including all vegetation trimming, but the Rangers were behind schedule on painting work.	
	Councillor Asker asked if the vegetation obscuring signage on Catons Lane was the responsibility of the Rangers. The Highways Liaison Officer explained that the Rangers work was reactive and she should submit a list of desired works to the Rangers; if any of the jobs listed were in their remit, they would schedule such tasks into their work programme.	
	The Chairman said there was a good spread of jobs completed across the district and congratulated the Rangers on their hard work.

The following report provides an update on the current position of all of the schemes which the Uttlesford Members had recommended for inclusion in the 2017/18 programme.

At the September panel meeting, members had discussed the schemes which were currently forming the 2018/19 rolling programme and agreed to remove four PROW schemes back to the potential schemes list for consideration in the new financial year. The specific schemes are listed below and were valued at £215,000 with two schemes remaining in the rolling programme.

UTTLESFORD DISTRICT COUNCIL WITH ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL – 15th JANUARY 2018 REPORT 2 – POTENTIAL CAPITAL SCHEMES

It is envisaged that the 2018/19 Capital budget for the Uttlesford LHP will be the same as that in 2017/18 (£236,000), though this will be finalised by ECC at their full Council meeting in February 2018. It is not yet been identified what Casualty Reduction schemes will need to be funded from this pot so this figure is subject to change. It will also be necessary to give consideration to funding any projects which have not been completed in 2017-18.

The value of the schemes currently on the potential list stands at £613,700 with further value set to be added upon the completion of outstanding feasibility studies and validations. This figure includes £215,000 worth of PROW schemes which had been provisionally agreed as part of the rolling programme but which have now been returned to the potential schemes list. Two schemes to the value of £28,000 remain in the programme.

Members are therefore invited to commence prioritising schemes to the value of £208,000 which will be finalised at the final meeting of the year. As with previous years a mix of feasibility studies and physical works are recommended to help form a deliverable programme.

Costs supplied are estimates only and there is the possibility that a final scheme cost can change significantly dependant on issues which may arise during detailed design and construction.
