BYWAY 42 BROXTED – DRAINAGE & SURFACE IMPROVEMENT

SCHEME OBJECTIVE: The existing route with its status as Byway provides an off-road walking, cycling and horse riding, carriage driving and motorised vehicular opportunity for the local community and the public in general especially amongst a number of other footpaths in the area.

The natural surfaced lane had become highly rutted and waterlogged and was very difficult to negotiate preventing use by most users. Therefore, the purpose of the scheme was to undertake improvement works (drainage and surfacing) to improve accessibility for all users.


SCHEME SUMMARY & OUTCOME: Regrading and Infilling of deep ruts and build up the sucken track with suitable graded material and overlaying with road planings. Creation of new grips where required to enable water to run off into the ditches on either side. Clearance of vegetation to the sides. The outcome of the works is a much-improved surface and drainage of this byway that has both a rural look and feel about it which allows a much safer passage of users along it.




















Works Approval
