TO THE PUBLIC AT LARGE AND TO THE OWNER AND OCCUPIER OF THE LAND DESCRIBED BELOW

The above Order made on 14 October 2021, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map for the area by:-

- 1. Upgrading to restricted byway (no. 67) a length of Footpath 63 Shalford from Iron Bridge Farm in a north, north easterly direction for a distance of 185 metres to the western bank of the River Pant north of the footbridge.
- 2. Adding a length of restricted byway (no. 67) from the western side of the River Pant, north of the footbridge ,fording the river and continuing in an easterly direction for a distance of 73 metres to the junction with Footpath 68.
- 3. Upgrading a length of Footpath 67 Shalford from the junction with Footpath 68 in a south-south easterly direction for a distance of 134 metres then turning east for a distance of approximately 110 metres before turning generally south to Lones Hall Lane south of Lones Hole

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Essex County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections, which have been duly made and not withdrawn, will be sent with it.
