#### Footpath 89 Little Baddow, Chelmsford City Order 2021

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Essex County Council on 22 June 2022 confirmed the above mentioned Order, and it took effect on that day.

The effect of the Order is to modify the Definitive Map for the County of Essex by:-

Adding a length of public Footpath (numbered 89) from Bridleway 37 (Fir Tree Lane) at Point A on the order plan in a generally northerly direction for a distance of approximately 224 metres to the ditch at Point B. From here it meanders in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 237 metres to meet Footpath 35 at Point C. The width of the way is taken to be 1.5 metres being that considered reasonable for two people to pass.

A copy of the Order and Order map may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at the Chelmsford Library, Market Road, Chelmsford, where copies will be available on request at a charge.

If any person is aggrieved by this Order and desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of section 53 or that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 have not been complied with in relation to it, he may within 42 days from the date of publication of this Notice make an application to the High Court under paragraph 12(1) of Schedule 15 to the Act.
