Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Essex

The Essex County Council Definitive Map Modification No. 700 Footpath 50 Great Horkesely (Colchester City) Order 2023

The above Order made on 23 August 2023 if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map for the area by:-

Adding a length of public footpath numbered 50 Great Horkesley from Brick Kiln Lane at Point A on the order plan in a generally southerly direction for 57 metres then turning south-east for a distance of 12 metres to meet Barnfield Road at Point B. The width of the way varies between 2.4 metres at Brick Kiln Lane reducing to 1.4 metres at the northern curtilage of 8 Barnfield Road.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at the Chelmsford Library, Market Road, where copies will be available on request at a charge. Copies can also be viewed on the Essex Highways website [Public Path Notices | Essex County Council \(essexhighways.org\)](https://www.essexhighways.org) and have been sent to Colchester City Council.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Director for Essex Legal Services, Essex County Council, Seax House, Victoria Road South, Chelmsford, Essex, CM1 1QH, to arrive not later than 9 November 2023, and it is requested that the grounds on which it is made are stated.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Essex County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections, which have been duly made and not withdrawn, will be sent with it.
