NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Essex County Council on 11 April 2024 confirmed the above mentioned Order and it took effect on that day.

The effect of the Order is to modify the Definitive Map for the County of Essex by:-

Adding a length of public footpath numbered 27 Wivenhoe from The Avenue, at Point A on the order plan, in a generally westerly direction for 99 metres to meet the adopted section of footway adjoining Parkwood Avenue at Point C. The width of the way varies between 3 metres between Points A and B (a distance of 87 metres), reducing to 2.1 metres for the final 12 metres to Point C.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at the Chelmsford Library, Market Road, where copies will be available on request at a charge. Copies can also be viewed on the Essex Highways website <u>Public Path Notices | Essex County Council (essexhighways.org)</u> and have been sent to Colchester City Council.

If any person is aggrieved by this Order and desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of section 53 or that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 have not been complied with in relation to it, he may within 42 days from the date of publication of this Notice make an application to the High Court under paragraph 12(1) of Schedule 15 to the Act.
