Notices in form 1 referred to above, were duly served on every owner, lessee and occupier of the land to which the Order relates, Chelmsford City Council (there is no parish council for Chelmsford) and prescribed persons as specified in Schedule 3 of the said Regulations. It was also specified in the site notice and newspaper advertisement that copies of the order and notice could be requested to be posted or viewed by emailing publicpathorders@essexhighways.org to arrange a suitable time to inspect the documents quoting the Order title. Documents can be made available for inspection 8.30am-4.30pm Mon-Fri at Essex County Council, County Hall, E block main reception, Market Road, Chelmsford if so required following the current social distancing restrictions.
4. A copy of the Notice and Plan were posted on site on 10th February 2021 by the co-applicant, Mr Mike Lawrence, due to snow preventing the PROW Inspector attending site (Appendix 5. MO Notice photos 1), and again on 15th February 2021 by Alan Roscoe, Area Public Rights of Way Inspector (Appendix 6. MO Notice photos 2).
