Good afternoon,

I am contacting regarding your attached document and the email below, which was sent to me in

response to my informal consultation of the 8th November (plan attached) re proposed footpath diversions.

Firstly, please note that the recipient seems to have for some assumed that I am my namesake who also used to work for Essex Highways (he left the organisation last month) though not in a Public Rights of Way role.

The contact address and telephone number in your objections correspondence are therefore incorrect and I would ask you please to remove them from future correspondence to avoid confusion.

With regard to your objection can you confirm please that is in respect of your asset, being a mains gas pipe marked in blue dashes on your plan, which runs both along Church Road and De Beauvoir Chase?

If so our plan made clear that neither road form part of either the current or proposed diversion routes of either footpaths and so your asset would not be affected.

I am therefore not clear on what basis you are objecting as you are not showing any apparatus anywhere on the diversion route.

Also, I would further advise that our consultation was on the proposed diversion of footpaths forming part of the rural PROW network and <u>not</u> an advice of works.

Whenever works are proposed though STATs checks are undertaken. This, however, is a proposal to legally move two footpaths where both the current and proposed routes already exist on the ground.

Please note that the moving of the footpath affects public rights only any private rights of access are unaffected.

I would be grateful therefore in light if the information above if you can confirm as soon as possible that your objection has been withdrawn as there does not seem to be any basis for it.
