
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 118 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL BRIDLEWAYS 39 AND 42 BROOMFIELD

This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that the bridleways described in paragraph 1 below are not needed for public use.

Chelmsford City Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

The public rights of way over the land situated between Channels Drive and Essex Regiment Way known as Bridleways 39 and 42 Broomfield in the City of Chelmsford and shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map BROOM 39E contained in this order and described in the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order.



SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

Bridleway 39 Broomfield

The entire length of Bridleway 39 of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the Order Map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 57196,21075 where it connects to the highway known as Channels Drive running in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 87 metres to point **D** at grid reference 57195,21066 then continuing in a southerly then veering to a westerly direction and finally a west south westerly direction for a final distance of approximately 265 metres to point **E** at grid reference 57171,21059 where it connects to the highway known as Essex Regiment Way.

Bridleway 42 Broomfield

The entire length of Bridleway 42 of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the Order Map commencing from point **B** at grid reference 57196,21073 where it connects to the aforementioned Bridleway 39 running in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 12 metres to point **C** at grid reference 57194,21074 then continuing in a southerly direction then an easterly direction for a final distance of approximately 80 metres to the aforementioned point **D**.
