NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2020 BRIDLEWAYS 39 AND 42 BROOMFIELD IN THE CITY OF CHELMSFORD

On 07/04/2022 Essex County Council confirmed the above made order under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to extinguish Bridleway 39 commencing from its junction with Channels Drive in the Parish of Broomfield CM3 3FB, proceeding in a southerly then westerly direction for a total distance of approximately 350 metres to its junction with Essex Regiment Way at grid reference 57171,21059, and to extinguish Bridleway 42 commencing from a point at grid reference 57196,21073 at its connection with the aforementioned Bridleway 39, proceeding in a westerly, southerly then easterly direction for a total distance of approximately 30 metres to reconnect with Bridleway 39, as shown on the order map.

The order comes into force on 06/05/2022, but If a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 28/04/2022 make an application to the High Court.
