## NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

### PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER FOOTPATH 10 BROOMFIELD IN THE CITY OF CHELMSFORD

The above order, made on 03 March 2023, under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980, will extinguish a part length of Public Footpath 10 Broomfield commencing from a point at its connection with Footpath 11 north west of St Mary with St Leonard Church CM1 7HA grid reference 57039,21052, proceeding in a north north-westward direction across the crop field then grass area to its connection with the new Cycleway/Footpath west of Church Avenue as shown on the order map.

Any representations about or objections to the Made Order may be sent in writing to Andrew Ritchings, Definitive Map Service, Essex County Council, Seax House, 2nd Floor, Victoria Road South, Chelmsford CM1 1QH no later than 14 April 2023. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Essex County Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If an order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent together with the order. Any such representations or objections will be taken into account by the Council with the result that they may be made available to the public under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985.
