# PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 119 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL FOOTPATH 25 CASTLE HEDINGHAM

This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The Applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.


Braintree District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1) The public right of way over the land situated to the south of the property Rushleygreen Farm in the parish of Castle Hedingham known as Footpath 25 Castle Hedingham in the District of Braintree and shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map numbered PROW-22-12 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated to the south of the property Rushleygreen Farm in the parish of Castle Hedingham known as Footpath 25 Castle Hedingham in the District of Braintree as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken black line on the order map numbered PROW-22-12 contained in this order.

#### SCHEDULE

#### (PART 1)

### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 25 Castle Hedingham of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference TL 78516 36107 running cross-field in a north easterly direction for a total distance of approximately 353 metres to point **B** at grid reference TL 78746 36365.

### (PART 2)

### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in a generally north easterly direction around a field edge for a distance of approximately 327 metres to point **C** at grid reference TL 78761 36312 then continuing in a northerly direction for a final distance of approximately 59 metres to the aforementioned point **B**.
