NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024 FOOTPATH 28 EPPING

On 16 July 2024 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert a part length of public Footpath 28 Epping commencing at grid reference 54695,20045 heading in a south easterly direction across the golf green for a distance of approximately 260 metres to the southern boundary of the golf course at grid reference 54704,20020 then continuing in a westerly direction following the southern boundary of the golf course for a final distance of approximately 200 metres to grid reference 54684,20018 where it continues unaffected to an alternative route 2 metres in width commencing from the aforementioned start point heading in a generally south westerly direction along the edge of the golf green and ponds for a total distance of approximately 304 metres to the aforementioned end point where it continues unaffected.

The alternative route comes into force on 13 August 2024, and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 20 August 2024, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 1 August 2024 make an application to the High Court.
