NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020 FOOTPATHS 25, 26 & 27 IN THE PARISH OF LITTLE CANFIELD

On 18 November 2024 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the order as confirmed as shown on the order map is to:

- 1) divert a part length of Footpath 25 commencing from its junction with Footpath 27 proceeding in a west north-westward direction across the field then westward through Langthorns to connect with Highcross Lane, to an alternative route commencing at the field edge at the southeastern corner of Langthorns, proceeding west north-westward at the field edge boundary to join Highcross Lane further south of its aforementioned original point.
- 2) divert a part length of Footpath 26 commencing from its junction with Footpath 27 proceeding initially north then west north-westward across the field to the southeast corner of Langthorns, to an alternative route commencing at the same point at the junction with Footpath 27 proceeding initially west south-westward, continuing west north-westward then north along the track across the field to join the aforementioned point at the southeast corner of Langthorns.
- 3) divert the entire length of Footpath 27 commencing from its junction with Footpath 25 at the field edge, proceeding south-westward west of the field edge to join Footpath 26 north of the ditch, to an alternative route commencing at the same point at the junction with Footpath 25 proceeding south-westward along the field edge then west south-westward to its original point at the junction with Footpath 26.

The alternative routes come into force on 17/12/2024 and the old routes will be stopped up with effect from 24/12/2024, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 28/11/2024 make an application to the High Court.
