NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020 FOOTPATH 16 IN THE PARISH OF LITTLE CANFIELD

On 18 November 2024 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert a part length of Footpath 16 commencing from its junction with Footpath 25 south east of Langthorns CM6 1TD grid ref: 55948,22051 proceeding in a general north-westward direction across an arable field then through Moat Farm to join Footpath 14 Little Canfield, to an alternative route commencing from the junction of Footpaths 25 and 27 proceeding generally north-eastward at the field edge to connect to Footpath 15 Little Canfield as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map can be requested to be posted or viewed by emailing publicpathorders@essexhighways.org, quoting the order title or is available to be viewed at Chelmsford Public Library, Market Road, CM1 1QH during normal working hours. Copies are also available on Essex Highways website at: www.essexhighways.org/public-path-notices and have also been sent to Uttlesford District and Little Canfield Parish Councils.

The alternative route comes into force on 17/12/2024 and the old route will be stopped up with effect from 24/12/2024, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 28/11/2024 make an application to the High Court.
