On 18 November 2024 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the order as confirmed is to extinguish a part length of Footpath 29 from its now dead-end connection to the pre-diverted route of Footpath 16 Little Canfield, proceeding eastward across the field to the footbridge stream crossing and diverted route of Footpath 16 as shown on the order map.

The Order comes into effect on 17/12/2024, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 28/11/2024 make an application to the High Court.
