**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2021  
FOOTPATH 49 GREAT DUNMOW**

The above order, made on 16th June 2021, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the entire length of Footpath 49 Great Dunmow of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the Order Map, commencing on Philpot End Lane and running in a south south easterly direction through Puttocks Farm and then in a generally southerly direction across an arable field to the corner of Mountains Farm Road near the property known as Coopers, to an alternative route 2 meters in width commencing from a point approximately 70metres further west along Philpot End Lane, running in a south south easterly direction across an arable field to the same end point on Mountains Farm Road.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Essex County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent together with the Order. Any such representation or objections will be taken into account by the Council with the result that they may be made available to the public under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985.
