
This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Uttlesford District Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1) The public right of way over the land situated south of High Street known as Footpath 25 Henham in the District of Uttlesford and shown by a bold continuous line on the order map numbered PROW-24-01 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated south of High Street known as Footpath 25 Henham in the District of Uttlesford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the order map numbered PROW-24-01 contained in this order.



SCHEDULE

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 25 Henham of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 55486,22843 at the private road known as Hall Close running in a north westerly then north north westerly direction through boundary features across a garden and along an access drive adjacent to Starr House/Garage for a total distance of approximately 42 metres to point **B** at grid reference 55483,22846 where it meets the publicly maintainable highway known as Starr Road.

(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in generally northerly direction along the private road known as Hall Close for a total distance of approximately 53 metres to point **C** at grid reference 55485,22849 where it connects to the publicly maintainable carriageway known as High Street.
