# NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024 FOOTPATHS 43 AND 45 HIGH EASTER

On 23 December 2024 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the order as confirmed as shown on the order map will divert:

#### Footpath 43 High Easter

A part length of Footpath 43 High Easter of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from the point where it meets The Street running in a south westerly direction between buildings for a distance of 57 metres to a point located at a field boundary where it meets Footpath 45 then continuing in a generally southerly direction along the field edge and through an outbuilding for a final distance of 185 metres to a point where it continues unaffected 15 metres north of the field boundary and junction with Footpath 42 High Easter, to an alternative route 2 meters in width commencing from a point at the field edge south of a pond running in a south easterly direction along a field boundary for a total distance of 212 metres to the aforementioned end point where it continues unaffected.

#### Footpath 45 High Easter

A part length of Footpath 45 High Easter of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from the point where it meets Footpath 43 running in a generally westerly direction along a field edge for a distance of 75 metres to a point approximately 19 metres from the field edge where it continues unaffected, to an alternative route 2 meters in width commencing from the aforementioned end point running in a generally northerly then generally easterly direction around the inside of a field boundary for a total distance of 283 metres to the point where it connects to The Street.

The alternative route will come into force on 20 January 2025 and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 27 January 2025, but if a person aggrieved by the orders wants to question their validity, or that of any provision contained in them, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 16 January 2025 make an application to the High Court.
