This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owners of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the paths should be diverted.

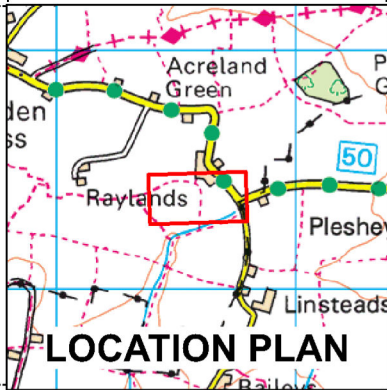
The landowners have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Uttlesford District Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1) The public rights of way over the land situated east of The Street in High Easter known as Footpaths 43 and 45 High Easter in the District of Uttlesford and shown by bold continuous lines on the order map numbered PROW-24-08 rev.18.04.24 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be public footpaths over land east of The Street in High Easter known as Footpaths 43 and 45 High Easter in the District of Uttlesford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the order map numbered PROW-24-08 rev.18.04.24 contained in this order.



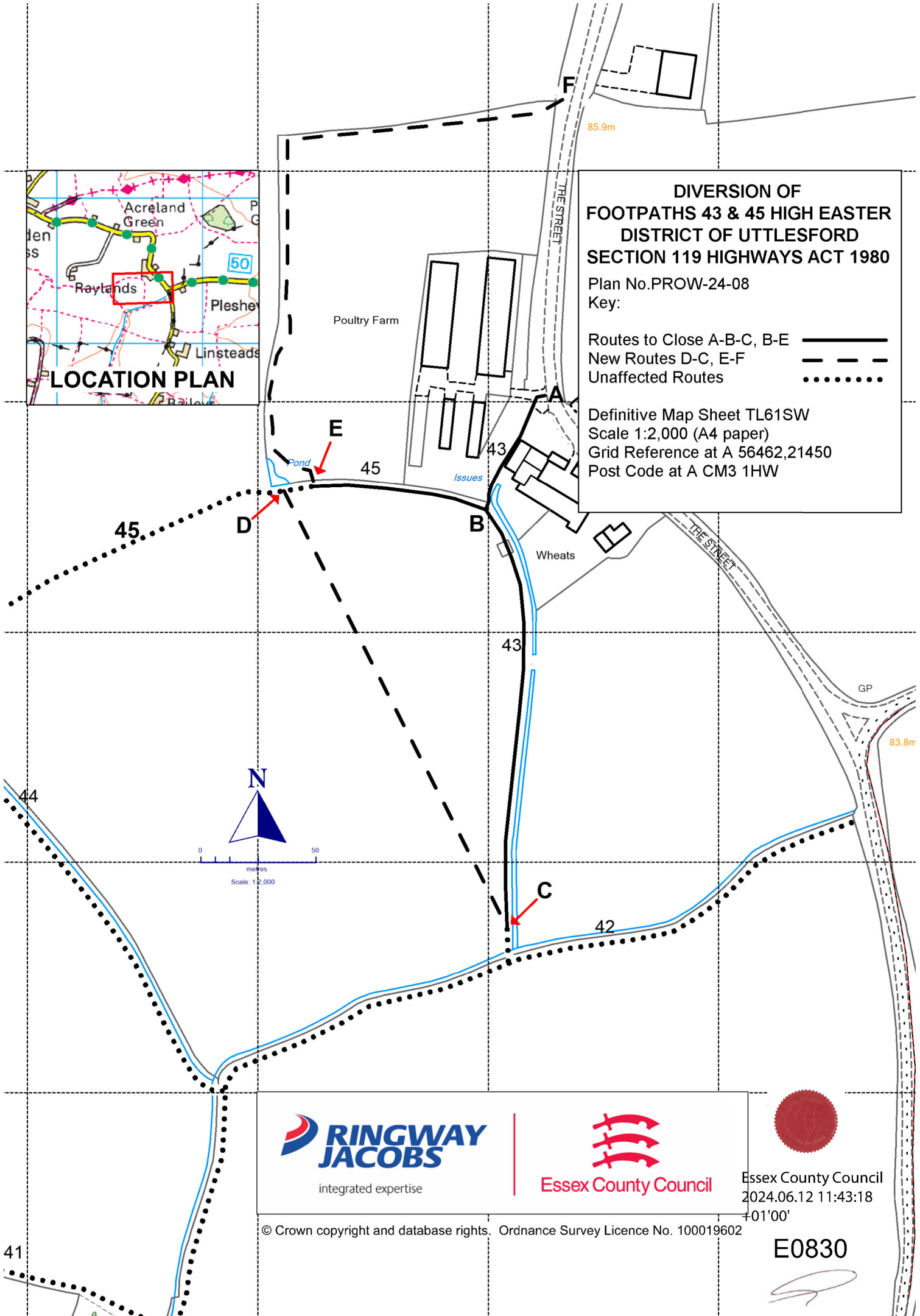
**DIVERSION OF

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

Footpath 43 High Easter

A-B-C

A part length of Footpath 43 High Easter of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 56462,21450 where it meets The Street running in a south westerly direction between buildings for a distance of approximately 57 metres to point **B** at grid reference 56459,21445 located at a field boundary then continuing in a generally southerly direction along the field edge and through an outbuilding for a final distance of approximately 185 metres to point **C** at grid reference 56460,21427 where it continues unaffected approximately 15 metres north of the field boundary and junction with Footpath 42 High Easter.

Footpath 45 High Easter

B-E

A part length of Footpath 45 High Easter of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from the aforementioned point **B** running in a generally westerly direction along a field edge for a distance of approximately 75 metres to point **E** at grid reference 56452,21446 approximately 19 metres from the field edge where it continues unaffected.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS OR WAYS

Footpath 43 High Easter

D-C

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at point **D** at grid reference 56451,21446 running in a south easterly direction along a field boundary for a total distance of approximately 212 metres to the aforementioned point **C** where it continues unaffected.

Footpath 45 High Easter

E-F

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at point **E** at grid reference 56452,21446 running in a generally northerly then generally easterly direction around the inside of a field boundary for a total distance of approximately 283 metres to point **F** at grid reference 56463,21463 where it connects to The Street.
