This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Brentwood Borough Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1) The public right of way over the land situated north of Mill Green House known as Footpath 25 Ingatestone and Fryerning in the Borough of Brentwood and shown by a bold continuous line on the order map numbered PROW-21-18 rev.09.11.21 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated north of Mill Green House known as Footpath 25 Ingatestone and Fryerning in the Borough of Brentwood as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the order map numbered PROW-21-18 rev.09.11.21 contained in this order.



SCHEDULE

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 25 Ingatestone and Fryerning having a recorded average width of 4 feet shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 56421, 20098 located at a field edge approximately 24 metres south south east of a pond running in a south south easterly direction along the field edge for a distance of approximately 80 metres to point **B** at grid reference 56424, 20091 at the south west corner of a field then continuing in an east north easterly direction along the field edge for a final distance of approximately 116 metres to point **C** at grid reference 56435, 20094 where it continues unaffected.

(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in a south easterly direction across a field for a total distance of approximately 146 metres to the aforementioned point **C** where it continues unaffected.
