This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.


The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Uttlesford District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

#### BY THIS ORDER:

- The public rights of way over the land situated southwest of the property known as The Grange on Finchingfield Road in the parish of Little Sampford known as Footpath 7 Little Sampford and Footpath 12 Little Sampford in the District of Uttlesford and shown by bold continuous black lines on the order map numbered PROW-22-11 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be two public footpaths over land situated southwest of the property known as The Grange on Finchingfield Road in the parish of Little Sampford known as Footpath 7 Little Sampford and Footpath 12 Little Sampford in the District of Uttlesford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken black lines on the order map numbered PROW-22-11 contained in this order.

# (PART 1) DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

## (i) Footpath 7 Little Sampford

The entire length of Footpath 7 Little Sampford of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference TL 64584 35162 running in a south easterly direction for a total distance of approximately 426 metres to point **C** at grid reference TL 64910 34897 where the path connects to Footpath 12 Little Sampford.

# (ii) Footpath 12 Little Sampford

A part length of Footpath 12 Little Sampford of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from the aforementioned point **C** running in a south easterly direction for a total distance of approximately 157 metres to point **D** at grid reference TL 65007 34776 where it continues unaffected.

# (PART 2) DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS OR WAYS

#### (i) Footpath 7 Little Sampford

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in a south easterly direction alongside the River Pant for a total distance of approximately 520 metres to point **G** at grid reference TL 64884 34853 where it connects to the new line of Footpath 12 described at (ii) below. (The width of this path is not to be constrained by fencing at any point).

#### (ii) Footpath 12 Little Sampford

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **G** running in a generally south easterly direction generally alongside the River Pant for a total distance of approximately 194 metres to the aforementioned point **D**. (The width of this path is not to be constrained by fencing at any point).
