
This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the paths should be diverted.

The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.

Uttlesford District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1) The public rights of way over the land situated east of Water Lane known as Footpaths 16, 17 and 18 Radwinter in the District of Uttlesford and shown by bold continuous lines on the order map numbered PROW-21-08 rev.28.04.21 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be public footpaths over the land situated east of Water Lane known as Footpaths 16, 17 and 18 Radwinter in the District of Uttlesford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the order map numbered PROW- PROW-21-08 rev.28.04.21 contained in this order.



SCHEDULE

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

Footpath 16 Radwinter

The entire length of Footpath 16 Radwinter of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **B** at grid reference 56115,23904 at the south eastern corner of the woods running in a north westerly direction across a field for a distance of approximately 103 metres to point **D** at grid reference 56108,23912 at the edge of the woods then continuing in a west north westerly then west south westerly and finally north westerly direction for a final distance of approximately 297 metres across a field and through a garden area to point **E** at grid reference 56081,23920 where it connects to Footpath 15 Radwinter.

Footpath 17 Radwinter

A part length of Footpath 17 of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 56069,23897 east of Water Lane running in an east north easterly direction for a total distance of approximately 463 metres across a field to the aforementioned point **B** where it continues unaffected.

Footpath 18 Radwinter

A part length of Footpath 18 of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **C** at grid reference 56088,23887 running in a north easterly direction for a total distance of approximately 320 metres to the aforementioned point **B** where it connects to Footpaths 16 and 17 Radwinter.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS OR WAYS

Footpath 16 Radwinter

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **B** running in a generally north westerly direction through a grassed area in an arc north of the existing route for a distance of approximately 107 metres to the aforementioned point **D** then continuing in a generally north westerly direction around the perimeter of the woods for a final distance of approximately 316 metres to point **I** at grid reference 56096, 23939 where it connects to Footpath 15 Radwinter approximately 246 metres north of its current connection point.

Footpath 17 Radwinter

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in generally southerly direction along the field edge for a distance of approximately 193 metres to point **F** at grid reference 56073,23878 then in a north easterly direction along the field edge to the aforementioned point **C** where it connects to the current route of Footpath 18 Radwinter. The path then continues in a south easterly direction to cross the field boundary for a final distance of approximately 6 metres to point **G** at grid reference 56088,23886 where it connects to Footpath 18 Radwinter.

Footpath 18 Radwinter

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **G** running in a north easterly direction at the field edge on the south side of a field boundary for a total distance of approximately 279 metres to point **H** at grid reference 56114,23896 where it connects to footpath 20 Radwinter.
