This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Chelmsford City Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.


BY THIS ORDER:

1) The public right of way over the land situated south of Church Green Roxwell known as Footpath 74 Roxwell in the City of Chelmsford and shown by a bold continuous line on the order map numbered PROW-21-07 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated south of Church Green Roxwell known as Footpath 74 Roxwell in the City of Chelmsford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the order map numbered PROW-21-07 contained in this order.

SCHEDULE

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 74 Roxwell of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 56448,20830 at the driveway to No.16 Church Green running in a generally southerly direction across the garden of No.16 for a total distance of approximately 32 metres to point **B** at grid reference 56448,20826 where it continues unaffected.

(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath of variable widths of between 1 and 1.5 metres shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in an east south easterly direction around the perimeter of the garden of No.16 Church Green for a distance of approximately 10 metres to point **C** at grid reference 56449, 20829 at the north eastern corner of the garden perimeter then continuing in a south westerly direction around the perimeter of the garden for a further distance of approximately 30 metres to point **D** at grid reference 56449,20826. The path then continues in a generally westerly direction around the perimeter of the garden of No.16 Church Green for a final distance of approximately 2 metres to the aforementioned point **B** where it continues unaffected.
