
This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Maldon District Council has been consulted and has consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

## BY THIS ORDER:

- 1) The public right of way over the land situated north of the property High House Farm Southminster Road in Asheldham known as Footpath 4 Tillingham in the District of Maldon and shown by bold continuous black line on the order map PROW-21-31 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated north of the property High House Farm Southminster Road in Asheldham in the District of Maldon as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken black line on the order map PROW-21-31 contained in this order.



#### SCHEDULE

# PART 1 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 4 Tillingham of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from Point A at grid reference 59713 20326 running in a generally westerly direction for a distance of approximately 80 metres to point B at grid reference 59706 20325 then running in a south westerly direction for a final distance of approximately 102 metres to point C at grid reference 59698 20319 where it continues unaffected.

# PART 2 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing from the aforementioned point **A** running in a generally south westerly direction along the track for approximately 42 metres to point **D** at grid reference 59709 20325 then running in a southerly direction along the field headland for a further distance of approximately 48 metres to point **E** at grid reference 59709 20320 then continuing in a westerly direction along the field headland for a final distance of approximately 115 metres to the aforementioned point **C** where it continues unaffected.
