NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257 AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14

PUBLIC PATH STOPPING UP ORDER 2022 FOOTPATH 66 WEST HORNDON

On 18 January 2023 Brentwood Borough Council confirmed the above order.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to extinguish Public Footpath 66 West Horndon commencing from its junction with Tilbury Road north of Hall Cottages at grid reference 56340,18920 postcode CM13 3LR, proceeding in an east north-eastward direction along the access track between Hall Cottages and East Horndon Hall, then curving round in a more northward direction across the industrial hard standing area to the foot of the embankment, where it then ascends the embankment northward to connect with the pedestrian footway adjacent to the Southend Arterial Road slipway at grid ref: 56355,18936 as shown on the order map.

The order comes into force on the date on which the order was confirmed but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
