NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023 FOOTPATH 22 WIDDINGTON

On 11 July 2023 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the order as confirmed as shown on the order map is to divert a part length of Footpath 22 Widdington of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from the junction with Footpath 21 Widdington running in a south westerly direction across a field and through boundary features for a total distance of 121 metres to the point where it connects to Footpath 20 Widdington and continues unaffected, to an alternative route 2 meters in width commencing at the aforementioned start point running in a north west then west south westerly direction across a field and then along the field edge for a total distance of 96 metres to a point where it connects to Footpath 20 Widdington.

Documents can be made available for inspection 8.30am-4.30pm Mon-Fri at Essex County Council, County Hall, E block main reception, Market Road, Chelmsford if so required following the current social distancing restrictions. The alternative route will come into force on 8 August 2023 and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 15 August 2023, but if a person aggrieved by the orders wants to question their validity, or that of any provision contained in them, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 27 July 2023 make an application to the High Court.
