# PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 119 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

## FOOTPATHS 20 AND 26 WIMBISH

This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owners of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the paths should be diverted.

The landowners have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.


Uttlesford District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

### BY THIS ORDER:

1) The public rights of way over the land situated at Hoys Farm known as Footpath 20 and Footpath 26 Wimbish in the District of Uttlesford and shown by bold continuous black lines on the order map numbered PROW-21-05 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be two public footpaths over land situated at Hoys Farm known as Footpath 20 and Footpath 26 Wimbish in the District of Uttlesford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken black lines on the order map numbered PROW-21-05 contained in this order.

3) The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.



#### SCHEDULE

## (PART 1) DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

#### Footpath 20 Wimbish

A part length of Footpath 20 Wimbish of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 558055 237473 running in an easterly then south easterly direction for a total distance of approximately 369 metres to point **B** at grid reference 558348 237287 where it continues unaffected.

#### Footpath 26 Wimbish

A part length of Footpath 26 Wimbish of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from point **D** at grid reference 558321 237719 running in a generally easterly direction around the north side of the pond past a barn and along the edge of a wooded area for a total distance of approximately 225 metres to point **E** at grid reference 558531 237684 where it continues unaffected

#### (PART 2)

#### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS OR WAYS

#### Footpath 20 Wimbish

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in a south easterly direction along the field headland for a distance of approximately 297 metres to point **C** at grid reference 558231 237234 then continuing in an east north easterly direction for a final distance of approximately 128 metres to the aforementioned point **B** where it continues unaffected.

#### Footpath 26 Wimbish

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing from the aforementioned Point **D** running in a generally easterly direction along the southern side of the pond and a hardstanding area for a distance of approximately 135 metres to point **F** at grid ref 558452 237677 before entering a wooded area then continuing in a generally easterly direction for a final distance of approximately 85 metres to the aforementioned point **E** where it continues unaffected.

## [PART 3] LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS

- 1.	At the point marked <b>PG1</b> on the order Map (PROW-21-05) located in the fence at grid reference 558323 237716	The right of the landowner to erect and maintain a pedestrian gate subject to its removal should the management of livestock cease in the area to which the gate is preventing the egress of animals, whereby a gap shall remain of 2 metres, this being the dedicated width of the path as specified in Part 2 of the Schedule
2.	At the point marked <b>PG2</b> on the order Map (PROW-21-05) located in the fence at grid reference 558339 237709	The right of the landowner to erect and maintain a pedestrian gate subject to its removal should the management of livestock cease in the area to which the gate is preventing the egress of animals, whereby a gap shall remain of 2 metres, this being the dedicated width of the path as specified in Part 2 of the Schedule
