**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2021  
FOOTPATH 14 WRITTLE**

On 25th August 2021 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order is to divert part of Footpath 14 Writtle of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the Order Map, commencing at its junction with FP13 west of Sturgeons House and running in a north easterly direction across a private garden and then running in a north westerly direction along a track, to an alternative route 1.5 meters in width commencing from the same point running in a north north westerly then north easterly direction around the edge of the garden and alongside the brook.

Copies of the order and order map have also been sent to Writtle Parish Council and Chelmsford City Council.

The alternative route comes into force on 22nd September 2021, and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 29th September 2021 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 9th September 2021 make an application to the High Court.
