PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 119 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL FOOTPATH 14 WRITTLE

This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.


Chelmsford City Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1) The public right of way over the land situated north west of Cow Watering Lane known as Footpath 14 Writtle in the City of Chelmsford and shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map numbered PROW-21-09 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated north west of Cow Watering Lane known as Footpath 14 Writtle in the City of Chelmsford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken black line on the order map numbered PROW-21-09 contained in this order.

SCHEDULE

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 14 Writtle of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from near its junction with FP13 Writtle at point **A** at grid reference 56618 20695 running in a generally north easterly then easterly direction across a lawned garden for a distance of approximately 100 metres to point **B** at grid reference 56627 20700 then continuing in a north westerly direction along a track for a final distance of approximately 38 metres to point **C** at grid ref 56624 20703.

(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 1.5 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in a north north westerly direction for a distance for approximately 32 metres to point **D** at grid reference 56617 20698 then continuing in a generally north easterly direction for a final distance of approximately 90 metres to the aforementioned point **C** where it continues unaffected.
