

Project Completion Notification

BYWAY 13 SHALFORD, BRAINTREE DISTRICT SURFACE IMPROVEMENT

SCHEME OBJECTIVE: The existing 1,711 metre route, with its status as Byway provides an off-road walking, cycling, horse riding, carriage driving and motorised vehicular opportunity for the local community. The route had become waterlogged with standing water even at the height of summer, deeply rutted, making it very difficult to negotiate and deterring any type of user from making use of the Byway. Therefore, the objective of the scheme was to undertake substantial improvement works – vegetation clearance and surface improvements to improve accessibility for all users.

SCHEME SUMMARY & OUTCOME: Infilling of ruts with suitable graded material (830 tons of concrete nuggets) and overlaying with road planings (530 tons). Clearance of vegetation to the sides and clearance of ditches where necessary in order to remove encroachments and make the route easier for all users. The outcome of the works is a much improved surface of this byway that allows a much safer passage for all users along it.

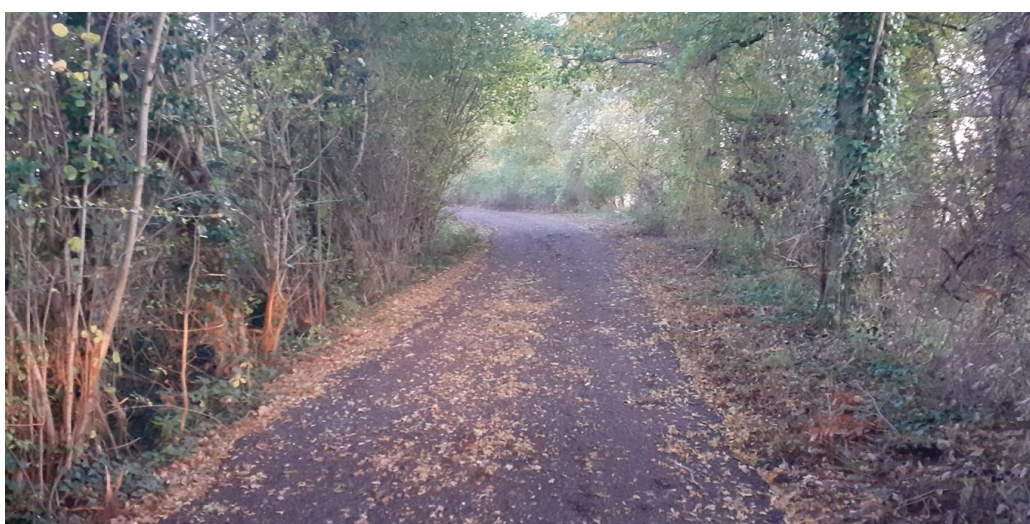
