



Project Completion Notification

Byway 57 High Roding and Byway 43 Great Dunmow – Drainage and surface improvements

SCHEME OBJECTIVE: To improve the drainage and ditches surrounding the nearby pond to prevent water flooding the byway and to improve the surface condition to support year-round use by all users.

SCHEME SUMMARY & OUTCOME:

The existing byway is 936m in length and mostly in good condition for all users. The southern end of the route however had been damaged and the drainage on the byway passing a large pond was poor resulting in frequent flooding of the byway over 130m of the lane. This waterlogging had in turn caused surface damage during usage in wet weather, resulting in rutting of the lane and rendering it impassable during the winter for many users. The improvement works have resulted in the lane being in good condition throughout and available to all users throughout the year.
