The Essex County Council (Epping Forest District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.14) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53, and Parts III and IV to Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order:

To revoke 'Resident Permit Holders Only Parking Area 'A', Mon-Fri 10am-5.30pm', to implement a corresponding section of 'No Waiting Mon-Fri 1pm-2pm' on following length of road in the District of Epping Forest:

Road	Description
Forest Edge, Buckhurst Hill	EAST SIDE: From a point approx. in line with common boundary of property No. 8 & 10 Forest Edge, northwards for approx. 6.7metres

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Epping Forest District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting tile numbers TQ415 935 revision 0 with revision 1.
