## The Essex County Council (B1389 Hatfield Road, Witham) (Prohibition of No Entry) Order 20\*\*

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), and 2(1) to (3) of the road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Essex County Council (B1389 Hatfield Road, Witham (Prohibition of No Entry) Order 20\*\*
- 2. Save as provided in Article 4 no person shall cause any vehicle to make a right-hand turn onto the B1389 Hatfield Road, north eastbound from the Co-Op Petrol Station access road, exit lane, in the District of Braintree onto the B1389 Hatfield Road, Witham [hereinafter referred to as the said length of road].
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle travelling south westbound on B1389 Hatfield Road to proceed into the Co-Op Petrol Station exit lane [hereinafter referred to as the said length of road].
- 4. Nothing in Article 2 or 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to make a right-hand turn in the said length of road specified in Article 2 or proceed in the said length of road in Article 3 if the vehicle is being used for Fire and Rescue, Police or Ambulance purposes.
- 5. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
