

**The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Wakering,
District of Rochford) (20mph Zone) Order 20***

The Essex County Council in exercise of its powers under Section S84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) (as amended) S36 of Road Traffic Act 1988, Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended), application 17/00862/REM and S90A-F of the Highways Act 1980, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 2, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the said lengths of roads, in the District of Rochford as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply if the vehicle is being used for Fire and Rescue, Police or Ambulance purposes.
3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
4. This order shall come into operation on and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Wakering, District of Rochford) (20mph Zone) Order 20**.

20 Miles Per Hour Zone

<u>Road</u>	<u>Description</u>
Kingfisher Street	From its junction with Minnow Lane, for its entire length, up to and including its junctions with Shallows Avenue
Waters Grove	From its junction with Sandy Crescent, for its entire length, up to and including its junction with Kingfisher Street
Shallows Avenue	From its junction with Kingfisher Street for its entire length, up to and including its junction with Waters Grove
Minnow Lane	From its junctions with Waters Grove for its entire length, up to and including its junction with Kingfisher Street
