

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Byways, Delfits Lane, Uttlesford) (Seasonal Prohibition Of Driving) Order 20**

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Orders under Sections 1(1) to (2), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the orders:

1. To revoke the Seasonal Prohibition of Driving 1 November to 31 March, on the following length of Byways, Delfits Lane in the District of Uttlesford

Name	Description
Byway 24, Broxted, Byway 99 Thaxted and Byway 22 Tilty	From a point at its junction with the B1051, Suckstead Green, south easterly for a distance of approximately 1,950 metres to its junction with the public road at Tilty Farm Lane

The Essex County Council (Byway 100, Wimbish; Byway 1, Little Henny/Byway 13, Middleton; Byway 61, Willingale (Lucas Lane); Byway 3, Pentlow and Hoe Lane; Byway 24, Broxted/Byway 99, Thaxted/Byway 22, Tilty (Delfits Lane)) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles and Horse Drawn Vehicles) Order 2019 is hereby revoked

The seasonal prohibition of driving will remain in force on Byway 100, Wimbish; Byway 1, Little Henny/Byway 13, Middleton; Byway 61, Willingale (Lucas Lane); Byway 3, Pentlow and Hoe Lane, by virtue of this order.
