The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Elsenham, Ugley, and Stansted Mountfitchet, District of Uttlesford) (Width Restriction) (Revocation) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 3(2) and Part IV of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") (as amended) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall cause any vehicle, the width of which, inclusive of any load on the vehicle, exceeds 2.0 metres, to proceed along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in any of the roads referred to in that Article, if the vehicle;
 - a) is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods, or merchandise to or from any premises on or adjacent to the roads affected by the Order.
 - b) is being used for the purposes of agriculture on those roads or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land.
 - c) is being used in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those roads, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of those roads, or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to those roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.
 - d) is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
 - e) is being used in an emergency for Fire and Rescue, Police, or Ambulance purposes; or
 - f) is a stage carriage (as defined by Section 117(1) of The Road Traffic Act 1960)
- 3. The Council are satisfied that for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads to which the Order relates or any other road and for preventing damage to the road or to any buildings on or near it, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply in relation to this Order.
- 4. 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Elsenham and Ugley) (Width Restriction) Order 1978' is hereby revoked, in its entirety.
- 5. No width restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
