

**The Essex County Council (St. Nicholas Street, Colchester)
(One Way) Order 202***

The Essex County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections S1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) (as amended), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. In this Order:
‘2016 Regulations’ means The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
‘pedal cycle’ has the same meaning as in the 2016 Regulations.
2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to travel on St. Nicholas Street in a southerly direction, from its junction with High Street, as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply if the vehicle is a pedal cycle or is being used for Fire and Rescue, Police or Ambulance purposes.
4. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
5. This order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as The Essex County Council (St. Nicholas Street) (One Way) Order 202*.

To introduce: One-Way Restriction on the following lengths of road, in the Borough of Colchester.

Road	Description
St. Nicholas Street	From its junction with Culver Street East and Long Wyre Street, in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 40 metres, to its junction with High Street.
