

# Public notice

## The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment 22) Order 20\*\*

**Notice is hereby given** that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

### Effect of the Order:

**To Revoke:** Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm, 1 Hour, No Return within 3 Hours Restriction on the following length of road in the District of Braintree

Road	Description
B1389 Newland Street	<b>Southeast Side:</b> From a point in line with the north eastern wall of number 59 Newland Street, south westerly, for a distance of approximately 8 metres

**To Revoke:** Disabled Badge Holders Only, 3 Hour Limit, No Return within 2 Hours on the following length of road in the District of Braintree

Road	Description
B1389 Newland Street	<b>Southeast Side:</b> From a point approximately 15 metres south west of the north eastern wall of 59 Newland Street, south westerly, for a distance of approximately 9 metres

**To Revoke:** 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions on the following length of road in the District of Braintree

Road	Description
B1389 Newland Street	<b>Southeast Side:</b> From a point approximately 24 metres south west of the north eastern wall of 59 Newland Street, south westerly for a distance of approximately 15 metres.

**To Revoke:** Bus Stop Clearway Restriction on the following length of road in the District of Braintree

Road	Description
B1389 Newland Street	<b>Southeast Side:</b> From a point approximately 38 metres south west of the north eastern wall of number 59 Newland Street, south westerly for a distance of approximately 15 metres

**To Implement:** 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions on the following length of road in the District of Braintree

Road	Description
B1389 Newland Street	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Southeast Side:</b> From a point in line with the north eastern wall of number 59 Newland Street, north easterly for a distance of approximately 4 metres</li><li>• <b>Southeast Side:</b> From a point approximately 8 metres south west of the north eastern wall of number 59 Newland Street, south westerly for a distance of approximately 6 metres</li></ul>



**To Implement:** Disabled Badge Holders Only, 3 Hour Limit, No Return within 2 Hours on the following length of road in the District of Braintree

Road	Description
B1389 Newland Street	<b>Southeast Side:</b> From a point in line with the north eastern wall of number 59 Newland Street, south westerly for a distance of approximately 8 metres

To Implement: No Stopping Except Buses Restriction on the following length of road in the District of Braintree

Road	Description
B1389 Newland Street	<b>Southeast Side:</b> From a point approximately 14 metres south west of the north eastern wall of number 59 Newland Street, south westerly for a distance of approximately 39 metres

This order will be incorporated into the Essex County Council (District of Braintree) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting Tile number TL820 142 Rev 0 for Rev 1
