

**The Essex County Council (Bell Common, Epping Forest)  
(Experimental Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 202\***

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”), in exercise of its powers under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the ..... Day of ..... 202\* and may be cited as the Essex County Council (Bell Common, Epping Forest) (Experimental Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 202\*.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be in that length of Bell Common, Epping Forest, as detailed in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The Order shall have effect for a period not exceeding 18 months from the date specified in Article 1 hereof.
4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
