Upgrade Traffic Signal Junction and Pedestrian Crossings at the junction of New London Road (B1007), Writtle Road, and Elm Road, Chelmsford

Widening of Traffic Signals and Pedestrian Line of Crossing on Elm Road, Chelmsford

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that under Sections 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Essex County Council proposes the following, in the City of Chelmsford:

1. To Refurbish the four sets of Traffic Signals and Pedestrian Crossings located at the junction of the New London Road (B1007), Writtle Road, and Elm Road, Chelmsford

The traffic signals and existing controlled crossing equipment used at this junction are to be upgraded to Extra Low Voltage (ELV) technology as part of the refurbishment of traffic signal technology across Essex. The traffic signal poles will be fitted with near-sided pedestrian signals (not far sided signals). The crossings will remain in the same location, but the Elm Road pedestrian line of crossing will be widened by approximately 1.2 metres (see below)

2. To widen the Traffic Signal set and Pedestrian Crossing on Elm Road at its junction with New London Road (B1007), Chelmsford.

The equipment and pedestrian crossing path between studs will be increased in width from 2.6 metres to 3.8 metres (an increase of 1.2 metres) to ensure that the new installation is to current standards. The proposed crossing centre line will be approximately 0.6 metres west of its current position. The double yellow lines are to be repositioned and reinstated either side of the crossing.

Further details: (1) The effect of the current parking restrictions (yellow lines) will remain in force by virtue of the crossing points and existing Traffic Orders. (2) The distance between the studs and stop lines at the pedestrian crossings will remain the same except for Elm Road as stated above. (3) No zigzags installed, as they are not required at a junction. (4) All the above measurements are approximate.
